HIGHLANDS

THE HIGHLANDS ARE BY FAR THE LARGEST WHISKY PRODUCING AREA OF SCOTLAND. OVER ONE HUNDRED DISTILLERIES ARE SPREAD IN SMALL SCATTERINGS FROM THE ORKNEY ISLANDS TO THE ISLE OF SKYE, OR IN THE DENSE CONCENTRATION OF THE SPEYSIDE. THE VARIETY OF TASTES ARE AS DIVERSE AS THE LOCALES WHERE HIGHLAND SINGLE MALT WHISKY IS MANUFACTURED.

SPEYSIDE

THE SPEYSIDE REGION IS GEOGRAPHICALLY LOCATED WITHIN THE HIGHLANDS, BUT THE SPEYSIDE DISTILLERIES ARE ALL ADJACENT TO THE RIVER SPEY, AND THEY ARE THOUGHT TO HAVE SUFFICIENTLY UNIQUE CHARACTERISTICS TO WARRANT A REGION OF THEIR OWN. THIS REGION BOASTS THE HIGHEST CONCENTRATION OF DISTILLERIES, AND THE WHISKIES THEY PRODUCE ARE KNOWN FOR THEIR SWEETNESS AND THEIR COMPLEX AND ELEGANT FLAVORS AND AROMAS.

NORTHERN COASTAL / EASTERN / WESTERN/
ORKNEY ISLAND

HIGHLANDS

THE NORTHERN COASTAL HIGHLANDS DISTILLERIES PRODUCE LIGHTER WHISKIES THAT ARE KNOWN FOR THEIR DELICACY, COMPLEX AROMAS, AND SLIGHT SALTINESS (DUE TO THEIR BEING DISTILLED BY THE SEA). THE EASTERN HIGHLANDS DISTILLERIES ARE KNOWN FOR WHISKIES WHICH ARE MEDIUM-BODIED, SMOOTH, AND SLIGHTLY SMOKY. WESTERN HIGHLANDS SINGLE MALTS ARE SOMEWHAT SWEET, HAVE A PEPPERY FINISH AND A HINT OF SMOKE.

ISLE OF SKYE

SIMILAR TO THE FLAVORS OF THE ISLE OF ISLAY, SKYE IS HOME TO ONLY ONE DISTILLERY TALISKER. THE TALISKER SINGLEMALTS WILL SHOW SLIGHTLY SWEET NOTES WITH PEPPER AND CAMPFIRE SMOKE.

ISLAY

(pronounced "eye-la")

IS A SMALL ISLAND OFF THE WESTERN COAST OF SCOTLAND, AND IT IS HOME TO THE HEAVIEST, STRONGEST-FLAVORED, SMOKIEST, AND MOST CHALLENGING OF THE SINGLE MALTS. THEIR STRONG FLAVOR IS THOUGHT TO BE DUE TO THE ISLAY REGION'S EXPOSURE TO THE HIGH WINDS AND SEAS OF THE WEST COAST. SALTY SPRAY IS BLOWN FAR INLAND, AND THIS CAN GET INTO THE WATER AND THE PEAT, BOTH OF WHICH ARE USED IN THE PRODUCTION OF ISLAY MALTS.

Johnnie Walker Red

Direct and fresh aromas on the nose, smooth & quite sweet on the palate. Full & appetizing finish. Excellent with soda or part of any classic Scotch whisky cocktail.

Complex aromas on the nose of dry smoke and sweet raisin. Big flavour with long, dark finish. Described by Jim Murray, author of the Whisky Bible, as the “Mount Everest of Scotch whisky”.

Concentrated, intense flavors of marine, wood smoke and florals. Spicy finish with hint of sweetness. Made with only malt whiskies – no grain whiskies are used in this blend. Best served on the rocks or neat with a glass of spring water.

Full, round and deep nose, enticing and sensuous. Rich and broad palate with full malt flavors, honeyed spices and nuts. A satisfying long and multi-dimensional finish. Best served frozen or in a chilled glass.

Made with only the finest and rarest whiskies available to Johnnie Walker. Harmonious and perfectly balanced nose with hints of smoke and a depth of sherry. Hugely flavorful on the palate with a rich peatiness, deep smoke and traces of spice. Well-balanced, long & intense finish with hints of smoke, Islay seaweed and vintage oaks. Perfectly served neat in a snifter with a glass of mineral water on the side.
